The one-tap reading app from your library



The Libby App is recommended for smart phones and tablets. Kindle Fire, Windows, Chromebook, and Mac users can use Libby on a web browser at libbyapp.com.

Install the free Libby app from your device's app store or point your web browser to libbyapp.com.

Answer "yes" to "Do you have a library card?" and continue following the prompts to find your library (Williamsburg Regional Library) and add your library card number.

To Read/Listen to Books

- Tap the magnifying glass at the bottom left to search.
**Tip: Use "explore filters" to browse formats, or type in keywords to search.*
- After tapping a title, tap Borrow if available or Place Hold to get in line.
**Tip: You may have 15 checkouts and 15 holds at a time.*
- Borrowed items appear on your shelf, which is the books icon at the bottom.
**Tip: Listen to audiobooks directly in the app.*
- From your shelf, choose "Open in Libby" for audiobooks.
For ebooks, choose "Read with..." and choose Kindle or Libby.



If you choose Kindle, you will be directed to Amazon's site where you will sign in with your Amazon account, and then click "get library book" button. The book will transfer to whatever Kindle devices you have linked to your Amazon account.



If you choose Libby, from your shelf, tap the cloud icon to the right of the title to download the title to your device. If using libbyapp.com in a web browser, you will need an Internet connection to read or listen to books.

To renew or return early, go to Shelf and tap Manage Loan next to the title.
